Applying for Membership

SECTION 1. The definition of a Pest Control Operator shall be:

The term "Pest Control Operator" as used in this charter of the Association shall mean a person, firm, corporation, or any business entity, who holds the appropriate licenses issued by the Texas Department of Agriculture (Structural Pest Control Service) allowing the person to operate as a pest control business; who maintains an office during normal working hours with attended telephone service and at least one service vehicle actually engaged in the performance of structural pest control services for hire to the public at large; who in performance of such services uses and employs pesticides and corrective measures; and who, conforms to the code of ethics set forth by the Greater Houston Pest Control Association.

SECTION 2. Active Membership shall be open to any Pest Control Operator who is licensed by the Texas Department of Agriculture (Structural Pest Control Service). No individual, firm or corporation, may have more than one active member in the Association. Any qualified representative may be designated, in writing, as the active member for a firm or corporation. All memberships should be held jointly between the person, firm or corporation, and the representative of the same. To transfer a membership, a new application shall be presented and shall be checked by the membership committee, and passed to the membership. Any misconduct or change of status of either of the above mentioned shall open a membership for investigation by the grievance committee which will have the power to recommend expulsion by the membership.

SECTION 3. Associate Members are persons employed on a full-time basis by industry or government who are in full accord with the Code of Ethics of the Association. Associate Members shall have all rights and privileges of active members except they shall not have voting power and cannot be a member of the Executive Board of Directors.

SECTION 4. Allied Members are persons, firms or corporations engaged in a business allied to the pest control industry. Allied Members shall have all rights and privileges of active members except they shall not have voting power and shall not be eligible for elected office.

Dues – Membership dues shall be payable in advance on January 1st of each year.
